



Access Statement for The Great Western Hotel, Narrowcliff, Newquay, Cornwall, TR7 2NE

Introduction

The newly refurbished Great Western Hotel in Newquay is a perfect spot to stay, eat and drink on Cornwall's breathtaking Atlantic coastline.

Set in the heart of Newquay, with a superb sea view, cliff top garden and terrace and only a few steps from the golden sandy beach and the sea, the Great Western Hotel offers some of the best value accommodation* in Newquay for relaxation, informality and comfort.

Steam, the Hotel bar and restaurant, offers the best in informal dining and socialising throughout the day and into the evening, with a menu of locally sourced dishes which blend Cornwall with the Mediterranean. All the food is freshly prepared and locally sourced where possible while the well stocked and stylish bar offers a full range of drinks.

Pre-Arrival

- Directions ~ You can arrive in Newquay by air, rail and road:
 - By road
Approaching Newquay on the A30. Leave the A30 sign-posted Newquay A392. Follow the signs for Newquay and continue for approximately 5 miles to Quintrell Downs. At the roundabout take the right-hand exit into Quintrell Road (A3058) over the level crossing (sign-posted Newquay Porth and Henvy Road). Carry along this road for approximately 3 miles. You go straight over two mini roundabouts. After the second one continue for 400yds. The Great Western Hotel is on the right.

- Parking
The hotel has very few parking spaces for residents. There is a large Pay and Display public car park on Tolcarne Road within a short walk of the hotel. Please ask at Reception when booking.

- By rail
Newquay is served by a branch line which links at Par to the mainline services from Penzance to London, the Midlands and the North. In peak season, First Great Western operates direct services from London Paddington to Newquay. The Great Western Hotel is a couple of minutes walk from Newquay Station.

- By air
Newquay Airport operates scheduled services to London Gatwick, London Stansted, Plymouth, Bristol, Birmingham, Leeds / Bradford, Manchester, Newcastle, Edinburgh and Dublin.

Arrival & Car Parking Facilities

- The hotel has very few parking spaces for residents. There is a large Pay and Display public car park on Tolcarne Road within a short walk of the hotel. Please ask at Reception when booking.
- The Car Park is well lit and adequately marked.
- Designated Disabled parking bay located at the front door entrance.
- Electronic door access pads located on the front door and entrance door to reception area.

Main Entrance, Reception & Ticketing Area

- Wide entrance with good access.
- Electronic door access pads located on the front door and entrance door to reception area.

- Low counter top available for wheelchair users.
- Adequate lighting throughout this area.
- Carpeted area all on one level with no steps or stairs in this area.
- Staff happy to assist when needed.
- Tables & chairs provided within this area which are also moveable.

Public Areas - Hall, Stairs, Landing, Corridors etc

- Adequate lighting throughout.
- Carpeted halls, stairs, landings and corridors with wide access throughout.
- WC's provided on ground level. See WC section below for more details.
- Passenger Lift provided to upper floors with good wide access.

Public Areas - Sitting room, lounges, lobbies etc

- Well lit areas, carpeted throughout except for the wooden dance floor.
- Wide access throughout this area.
- Moveable furniture (tables / chairs) within this area.
- Flat ground floor with no steps or stairs within this area.

Public WCs

- The WC's are found on the ground floor just behind the Reception area and en-route to the Bar / Restaurant areas.
- A Disabled WC is also provided. RADAR locked with key available at the Bar. Please ask any member of Staff who will be happy to get the key for you.
- The Disabled WC is unisex with baby changing facilities.
- An Emergency pull cord installed and can be heard in Reception.
- There is good wide access throughout the Disabled WC with the following measurements: Sink 735mm / Toilet 480mm.
- Handrails are provided within the Disabled WC.

- Allergies and special dietary requirements are catered for; please call in advance to discuss your needs.
- WC's are located in the corridor en-route to the Reception area.

- The Great Western Hotel, Newquay has 42 bedrooms all Ensuite.
- A bedroom has been specially designed for wheelchair users. Please Tel: (01637 872010) to check for availability of this room.
- Located on the first floor with access via the lift (which has Braille push buttons) the corridor is 1340mm wide at its narrowest.
- The door into the room is 815mm wide. It has a double and a single bed, TV, Kettle with Tea & coffee, a large walk in closet with low coat hooks & clothes rail. The light switches for the rooms are also provided at 960mm from the floor. The bathroom has a wide 815mm access. Fitted with handrails for the WC and the bath also low light switches for this room. The sink is 815mm high / the WC is 355mm high. Adequate lighting throughout, carpeted and on one level.
